Features:

- Distinct and unique variegated foliage and flowers
- Foliage displays tones of cream and green-blue with stunning red-pink colouring throughout cooler months
- Spikes of flowers in a blend of cream, lime, and green appear from late winter through early spring
- Tolerant of extreme heat and dry conditions

Suggested Uses:

- Stunning container displays
- Water wise gardens
- Dry or gravel style gardens or xeriscaping
- Coastal gardens

Water Requirements:

Dry tolerant once established, requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

Care:

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser according to manufacturer's directions. If pruning, take care to avoid contact with sap. **CAUTION : Harmful if eaten/skin & eye irritant**
