















FEATURES

- A popular evergreen shrub with glossy green leaves, and young red shoots
- Produces small white flowers in late spring

USES

- Is often planted as a specimen shrub or as a fast-growing, dense, evergreen hedge
- For best results plant 50 - 60 cm apart

POSITION

Photinia grows best in fertile, moist, well-drained soil in sun or partial shade in a sheltered position

CARE

Tolerant of most soils, as long as it has been improved by well-rotted compost or manure. Will suit either acid or alkaline conditions. Requires minimal pruning, trim in spring and summer. Avoid trimming after mid-August, any new growth would be vulnerable to frosts
