



Tough dwarf, compact and very low maintenance.

'Little Jess' only grows to about half the height of many forms of Dianella caerulea; about 40cm high (high nutrition can make it higher). It is a great commercial and domestic plant. It has excellent humidity tolerance, and good cold tolerance.







Dianella caerulea is known as one of the most drought tolerant, hardy Flax Lilies. Underground rhizomes ensure excellent cold survival. 'Little Jess' has very short, compact canes and it will not fall over like common Dianella caerulea which generally have long canes. An estimated trimming once every 8 years, makes this about the lowest maintenance plant there is. It's the best low growing erosion control plant but may discolour in very cold climates like Canberra.
